

PRIVACY NOTICE - REGISTRATION FOR "CIVETTA A TOLECH 2026"

Pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 (hereinafter "GDPR"), which contains provisions for the protection of individuals and other subjects with respect to the processing of personal data, we wish to inform you that the personal data you provide will be processed in compliance with the aforementioned legislation.

The provision of personal data by the competitor is optional; however, refusal to provide such data will make it impossible to complete the registration process. The data must be complete, up-to-date, and legible, including for insurance purposes.

1) Data Controller

2) Types of data collected

Participation in the Event and the provision of related services involve the processing of participants' personal data such as: email address; personal details and membership details of sports clubs/organizations; images captured via video and photos; transit times at checkpoints and/or timing; geographic location data for participants using a device for geographic location tracking and related services.

Data relating to the data subject's health (obtainable from medical certificates or declared directly by the data subject) may also be processed where strictly necessary for registration and participation in the Event.

3) Purpose of processing

The use of the personal data indicated above is inherent in the sporting and public nature of the Event, its organizational needs, and the provision of the planned services to participants.

The Data Controller uses and processes the data, including through its technical and service partners and associated companies, for the following purposes: verification of participation requirements; timing and tracking services; medical assistance services; photo and video services for the media and participants (including paid services); communications to sporting and public authorities; reporting and documentation of the Event; promotion and commercial exploitation of the Event.

Unless you expressly object, your contact details will also be processed for the purpose of sending promotional communications via email (see point 7 of this Privacy Policy).

4) Legal basis for processing

The processing of the personal data (including sensitive data) provided by you is based on Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of the GDPR. B of the GDPR, that is, it is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or for the implementation of pre-contractual measures adopted at the data subject's request. Promotional purposes, on the other hand, have the legal basis of Art. 130, paragraph 4 of Legislative Decree 196/03.

The processing of sensitive data (e.g., health status) occurs pursuant to Art. 6, paragraph 1, letter D and Art. 9, paragraph 2, letter C of the GDPR (protecting the data subject's vital interests).

5) Acquisition of participant images

The Data Controller notes that during the Event, video recordings and photographs of participants will be taken, both in motion and in still poses. For example, photographs and videos may be taken before, during, and after the race, live broadcasts of the Event (including via social networks).

Given the public nature and purpose of the Event, please note that the footage is strictly related to the Event and therefore, it is not possible to object to its acquisition. All images obtained will be used by the Owner, free of charge and without territorial or time restrictions, to promote the Event and other events organized through websites, social media channels, print media, and/or any other means of dissemination/publication, even atypical. For reporting and documentation purposes of the Event, the audiovisual material may also be used by sponsors and technical partners of the Owner. Any further and different use of the material will be subject to a specific request for consent.

6) Scope of circulation and dissemination of data

Participants acknowledge and accept, given the public nature and purpose of the Event, that data relating to their image, times and results, and position during the race may be made publicly accessible and/or communicated to third parties for reporting, documentation, and promotion of the Event itself, for the provision of specific services, as well as in fulfillment of specific legal or regulatory obligations and for the protection of the vital interests of participants, for example, communication to competent authorities and emergency personnel for rescue operations and/or the provision of medical assistance services during the Event.

The Data Controller informs participants that the Event is organized and managed through the services of technical and commercial partners and with the support of sponsors. Some of these services may require or presuppose registration of the data subject on the partner's platform or, in any case, processing may be carried out by the partner as an independent data controller; in such cases, the data subject is invited to carefully read the privacy policy provided by the partner. The data subject may obtain a list of partners and sponsors at any time by contacting the Data Controller.

7) Communications for promotional purposes

The Data Controller informs participants that - pursuant to art. 130, paragraph 4 of Legislative Decree 196/03, unless expressly objected to by sending an email to atleticazoldo@gmail.com - the contact information provided may be used to send email communications related to the Event or of a commercial nature, relating to products and services promoted by the Data Controller and similar to those used by the participant. Participants retain the right to object to such processing at any time.

8) Data Retention

Participants' data will be stored in the Data Controller's archives in automated and/or manual form, in compliance with the provisions of Article 32 of GDPR 2016/679 regarding security measures.

The data will be retained for the time necessary for the purposes indicated above and, if necessary, for a further period of time if data retention is necessary to protect the rights of the Data Controller or a third party; Data relating to the results of the Event will be retained for as long as there is a continuing interest in documenting the Event; contact details for sending commercial communications will be retained until the interested party exercises their right to object; data relating to the image of participants will be retained for as long as the Data Controller has legitimate access to the footage of the Event.

For the purposes of retention and, more generally, processing, the Data Controller may use third parties under its own responsibility; these parties, where applicable, will be appointed as Data Processors pursuant to Art. 28 of EU Regulation 679/2016.

9) Transfer of data outside the EU

Your data will not be transferred to third countries outside the European Union.

10) Minors

Registration of minors to Events is permitted only by those exercising parental or legal responsibility for the minor or who have obtained the necessary prior authorization from the latter.

Participants exercising parental or legal responsibility for the minor may exercise the rights specified in Article 11 below with reference to the minor's personal data.

11) Rights of the Data Subject

Participants may exercise their rights regarding the processing of their personal data at any time pursuant to Articles 15-22 of EU Regulation 679/2016. These rights include:

- a. Access: The data subject may obtain information regarding the processing of their data and a copy of such data.
- b. Rectification: If they believe their data is inaccurate or incomplete, they may request that such data be amended accordingly.
- c. Erasure: The data subject may request the erasure of their data if they withdraw their previous consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing, or in other cases provided for by law.
- d. Restriction: In the cases provided for by law (for example, if they contest the legitimacy of the processing or the accuracy of the data), the data subject may obtain the restriction of the processing of their data without their erasure.
- e. Objection: The data subject may object to the processing of their data if the processing is based on a legitimate interest of the Organizer for reasons related to their particular situation, unless there are compelling reasons why the interests of the Organizer prevail over their rights (for example, if the processing is necessary for the defense of a right of the Organizer in court).
- f. Withdrawal of consent: The data subject may withdraw the consent previously given for the purposes of processing.

The interested party may, at any time, object to the processing of their data for commercial purposes and withdraw their consent given.

The aforementioned rights may be exercised by sending a written communication to the Data Controller at atleticazoldo@gmail.com.

In accordance with applicable law, in addition to the rights listed above, the interested party also has the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority.
